GOVERNANCE THE CHICKEN CHAIN IN VIETNAM: A CASE STUDY IN KIM DONG DISTRICT, HUNG YEN PROVINCE

Chicken raising is a traditional occupation and plays an important role in the socioeconomic development of Vietnam. However, chicken raising in Kim Dong district, Hung Yen
province of Vietnam is currently still spontaneous, small-scale, and easily vulnerable, which
lead to the inefficiency in the chain activities, and all the chain actors will have less benefit.
This study aims to analyze the real situation of governance in the chicken chain and
proposed ecommendations to strengthen the governance and improve the efficiency of the
chicken chain in Kim Dong district based on the surveyed data of 70 chicken chain actors.
The findings showed that the chicken chain was undeveloped with the typical low market
governance. The chain actors included suppliers, farmers, traders, retailers and a few
