# Automatically create your publications lists via ORBi

# Avantage of « Made in ORBi » lists

☺ **1 source**  
– **official and central** –  
**for every publications of the ULg**

☺ Extended possibilities for the query

☺ For personal use (1 author) or for groups (departement, service...)

☺ Automatic generation to international bibliographic standards

☺ templates defined and validated by the faculties and the FNRS

☺ Automatic integration of bibliometric indicators (for the reports)

☺ Link to detailed reference and full text

☺ Output in different formats (pdf, text, html, web code ...)

☺ Lists of publications easy to spread or re-use beyond ORBi

☺ No more manual update as often as a new report is requested

# Who, What, When?

## Who can create a publication list from ORBi?

- Identified ULg's members (Uxxxxx, Cxxxxxx, Sxxxxxx + e-mail)
- Exteriors can only use the research options – new exporting functions will be available in the future

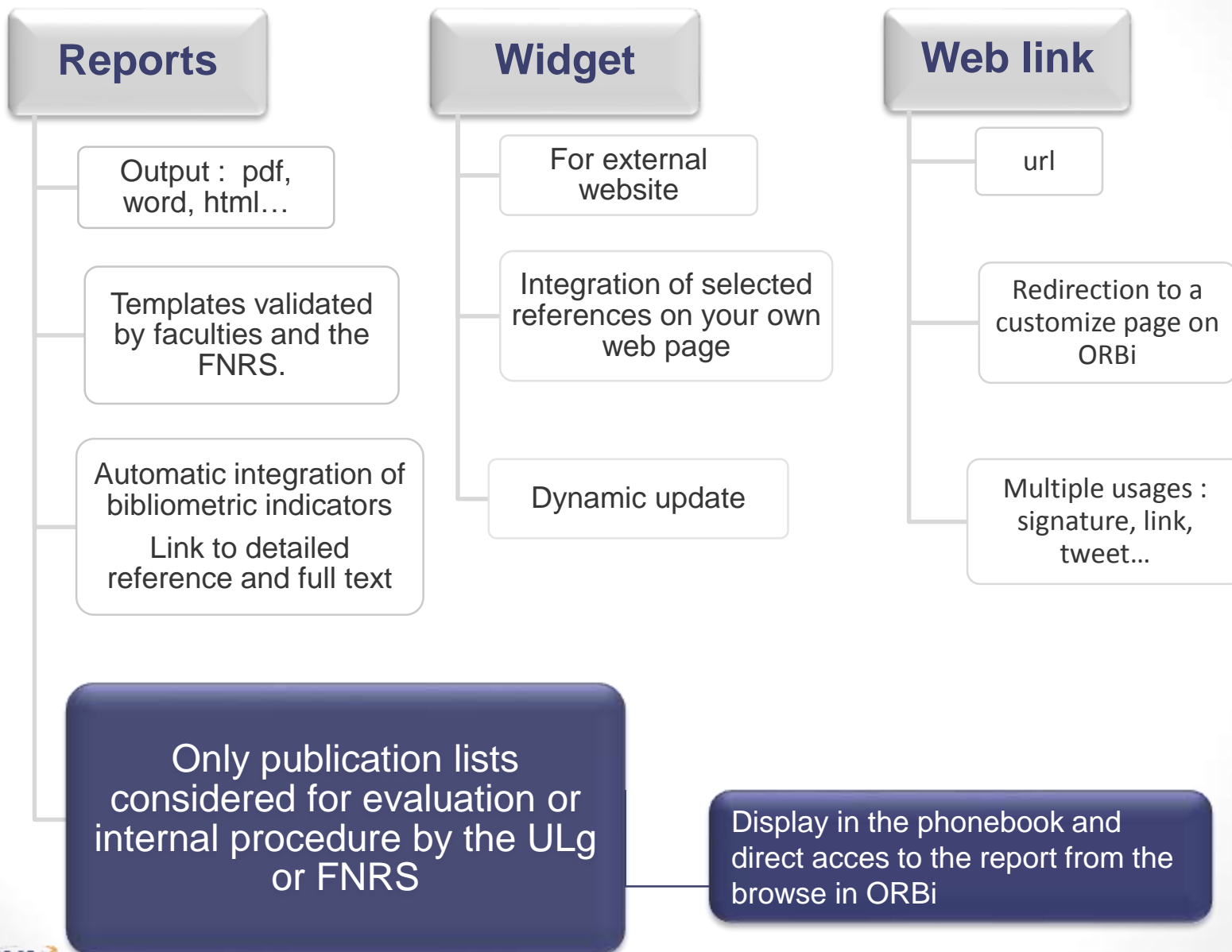
## What reference can appear in a publication list?

- Every reference visible in the public interface (archive)
- References « in process » will not appear in any publication lists
- Many criteria may be applied to customize the selection (1 or many author, keyword, date range... )

## When can I create a list ?

- At any given time! The generation is immediate
- There is no delay between the apparition of a reference in the public interface and in the publication list
- Only the bibliometric indicators may not be up to date if the reference is new

# 3 Tools



# Bibliometric indicators

- **Impact factor:** of the year or IF5 (5 year period), until 2014
- **EigenFactor Score:** claim to be an amelioration of the IF. The EF score do not take account of auto citations, adjust for citation differences across disciplines and is calculated based on the citations received over a 5 years period.
- **Article Influence Score:** EigenFactor divided by the number of articles published in the journal
- **Scopus citation:** number of citations picked up by Scopus
- **h-index:** In ORBi, the "h" index is based on the number of Scopus citations of the references listed in the report.
- **ORBi metrics : download and vizualisation:** these are « human » access, robots and others automatic coutners are filtered

The impact factor after 2014, Google Scholar citations and WoS citations are not available anymore

The update of these indicators is dependent of the quality of the reference (names of authors, periodical titles, date of publication... must be exact)



Updates are daily and weekly  
**NOT AT THE CREATION of the list!**
